

Doll Skin – Bio

If life was a comic book, Doll Skin would be right at home in the larger than life color pages as teenage, punk rock superheroes, wielding mighty guitars while they battle tyranny and oppression with adrenaline-fueled rock anthems. Don't get the wrong idea, Doll Skin is just as much The Runaways as they are Josie and the Pussycats and in that polarized dichotomy lies the heart of Doll Skin: young, pretty, colorful, and dangerous.

Formed in Arizona in 2013, Doll Skin is made up of: Vocalist Sydney Dolezal (16), Guitarist Alex Snowden (17), Bassist Nicole Rich (18), and Drummer Meghan Herring (19). They came to the attention of Megadeth bassist David Ellefson, who took the band under his wing, and together they began a sonic assault on the West Coast building an impressive fan base. They've played shows with Green Jello, DRI, SLUNT, Dead Kennedys, Metal Allegiance, Hell Yeah, Shiprocked Cruise and many more, all throughout the country. Their infectious songs rapidly found their way into playlists across America, including over 20 spins on uber-influential LA Rock station KROQ, where the band has become a favorite of legendary DJ Rodney Bingenheimer.

The band was also a huge hit at 2016 Winter NAMM, where the band performed at the indie Schecter Guitars party, doing several massive signings with the likes of David Ellefson and Runaways guitarist Lita Ford herself.

Doll Skin released their debut full length album "*In Your Face (Again)*" on April 15, 2016 through Ellefson's own imprint EMP Label Group, distributed in North America by eOne, which sees Ellefson handling producing duties as well.

Says Ellefson. "When I was first introduced to Doll Skin, I knew there was something really special there. Through working with them as a producer, it became even more apparent what these girls were capable of."

Vocalist Dolezal echoes David's sentiment, "Working with David has been one of the most amazing experiences you could imagine. He's such a cool guy, and a great producer, and has created such amazing opportunities for us."

Doll Skin just wrapped up a successful national tour this spring with Otep, Lacey Sturm, September Mourning and Through Fire and will be heading back out onto the road as direct support for Otep Summer 2016.
